Barbara Bush Houston Literacy Foundation and HCA Houston Healthcare Expand Raising a Reader Initiative

11,000 new mothers to receive literacy resources by end of 2024

Houston, Texas (March 19, 2024) –The Barbara Bush Houston Literacy Foundation and HCA Houston Healthcare are excited to announce the expansion of the newly created Raising a Reader program. Launched in November 2023 during National Family Literacy Month, Raising a Reader aims to give more babies a strong, healthy start. Recognizing the pivotal role of parents and caregivers as their child's first teachers, this innovative initiative aims to provide families with the tools they need to support their child's growth, promoting early literacy, healthy brain development and a strong foundation for infants. The expanded program will ensure that 11,000 new mothers at HCA Houston Healthcare Clear Lake, HCA Houston Healthcare West and The Woman's Hospital of Texas receive information and resources before they leave the hospital following the birth of their babies.

Funding to support Raising a Reader is made possible by HCA Houston Healthcare, contributions from the Foundation's Young Professionals Group and Ladies for Literacy Guild and general funds invested by the Foundation.

"Nearly eighty-five percent of brain development occurs during the first three years of life," said Dr. Julie Baker Finck, President & CEO, Barbara Bush Houston Literacy Foundation. "What parents and caregivers do with their infants and toddlers during this time to help their brains make connections and foster oral language development is critically important. Healthcare providers, particularly nurses, play a vital role in educating and equipping parents to be their child's first and most important teachers, setting them on a path to lifelong success."

The Raising a Reader program first launched in November 2023 and ran through the holiday season, concluding at the end of the calendar year serving 920 families at HCA Houston Healthcare Clear Lake and HCA Houston Healthcare West.

"The success of the Raising a Reader program through the 2023 holiday season is evidenced by feedback from participating mothers and the excitement of our amazing nurses," said Kimberly Williams, Assistant Vice President of Community Engagement at HCA Houston Healthcare. "We are delighted to invest in the expansion of the program with the Barbara Bush Houston Literacy Foundation into 2024, as our commitment to nurturing early childhood development, empowering new mothers, and enhancing the overall well-being of our community remains as strong as ever. We look forward to seeing what this year brings."

New mothers participating in the program will receive a Raising a Reader bag, which includes an indestructible book, a brochure with informative resources with suggested activities for fostering healthy brain development and early literacy, a library card accessible for any public library in Texas, and a prescription to read to their baby for at least 15 minutes every day.

HCA Houston Healthcare Clear Lake, HCA Houston Healthcare West and The Woman's Hospital of Texas will actively support and educate parents about the program by displaying customized Raising a Reader content on closed-circuit monitors in labor and delivery rooms. This content will provide fast facts about the importance of early literacy, tips for parents on supporting early literacy success and healthy brain development and guidance on what children should know and be able to do by the age of two.

Moreover, physicians, nurses and other hospital staff will consult with new mothers about the Raising a Reader resources before they are discharged, ensuring they are fully equipped to embark on their journey toward building a strong foundation for their child's future.
